THE LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

This is Six-Month Professional Training Program (TPT) geared towards creating access for university graduates desiring to develop professional skills. The goal is to produce skillful managers that meet with International Standard of Leadership. Four-month classroom training and two-month internship services. Upon graduation, CEEFF is obligated to place graduates on jobs. Classes run from Monday-Saturdays and time is 5:00 to 7:00 PM.

Training Programs;

- I. Leadership and Management Program (LMP) with emphasis on Leadership, Sustainable Development Management, International Relations and Diplomacy, Result Based project management, International relations and others.
- II. Leadership and Social Work (LSW) with emphases on Leadership, Community development, Result Based project management. Monitoring and Evolution; Sustainable Development Management; and Fund Raising and Grant Management
- III. Graduates Career Advancement with emphases on job ethics, International standard of employment procedures, international economic work readiness, and others.
